



#### Admission to full-time

- 3 Years Higher Nitec and 2 Years Nitec courses
- Merit based
- Aggregate of best 4 GCE 'N' Level subjects, including pre-requisite subjects and bonus points
- A lower aggregate point is indicative of better performance
- Selected courses will require applicants to attend interview/aptitude
  - test. Computation of ITE Aggregate Points for Normal (Technical) Subjects

#### 2 Years NITEC (+ 2 Years Higher NITEC if eligible)

### 2 Years NITEC Programme

- 2 years of NITEC study that equip students with industry-relevant skills.
- After 2 years of NITEC studies, students can apply for fulltime *Higher NITEC* and Technical Diploma courses if they meet the entry requirements.
- Students who perform very well in their NITEC have the opportunity to apply directly to Polytechnic if they meet the entry requirement.
- Eligibility does not ensure placement.

# ITE Traineeship

### Traineeship (1-2 years)

- Learn valuable skills in an actual work environment
- Earn a full time salary at the same time
- 1-2 years
- On-the-job training: work under the supervision of an experienced and qualified trainer in the sponsoring company.
- Off-the-job training: attend theory and practical lessons at the selected ITE College / ITC Approved Training Centre and work at the sponsoring company.

#### ITE Early Admission Exercise (EAE)

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- Allows you to apply for ITE courses based on your aptitude and interests before taking N-level.
- Receive conditional offer for admission to ITE if successful.

Should your child apply for ITE EAE?

- If your child is sure of the course he would like to pursue at ITE
- Strong aptitude and passion in a field related to a Higher Nitec/ Nitec course



## Application for EAE

- Apply end of May (1 week period), dates TBC in ITE website
- Can apply for up to 3 course choices
- Write up of no more than 100 words per course
   O Portfolio of related work / projects,
  - Participation in MOE Elective Modules, applied Subjects, ITE Skills Subjects, and/or Elective Module
  - Participation in work attachments, community/volunteer work, school/personal activities/projects, CCAs and competitions
  - Relevant work experience
